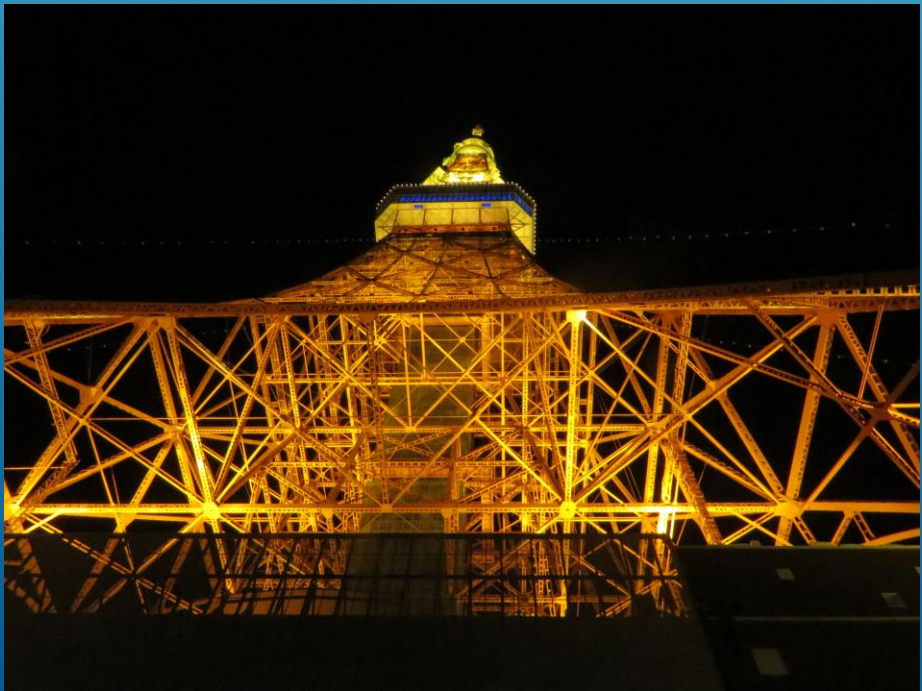


TOKYO TOWER

Tower with elegant shape
constructed human power





- Eiffel Tower-inspired steel lattice tower completed in December 1958.
- The tallest freestanding tower in the world, 333m, when it was built, taking the title from the Eiffel Tower by nine meters.
- It has two observation decks, top deck 250m, lower deck 150m



- Construction was made by human power, traditional construction workers, Tobi, who specialized in the construction of high-rise structures
- It was constructed of steel, a third of which was scrap metal taken from US tanks damaged in the Korean War.
